

PROCLAMATION OF A CIVIL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the undersigned Mayor of the City of Long Beach, Mississippi, as Chief Administrative Officer of said City, does now find, determine and adjudicate, that conditions of extreme peril to the public health and safety of the citizens and property in the City of Long Beach, Mississippi, do now exist, caused by torrential rain, flooding, wind and storm surge damage and other related disastrous consequences created by Tropical Storm Ida, anticipated to become Hurricane Ida by landfall on or about August 29, 2021; and said conditions warrant the proclamation of a civil emergency as defined in §45-17-1 of the Mississippi Code, Annotated; now therefore

IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED, that a civil emergency is hereby deemed to exist within the City of Long Beach, Mississippi, as of the date hereof, until its termination is further proclaimed by the undersigned Mayor of the City of Long Beach, Mississippi.
