Packet Deadline for Applying: Wednesday, June 18, 2025

Application for membership in the Mayor's Youth Council is open to any 11th grade and 12th grade students who attend high school or reside within the geographic boundaries of the City of Long Beach. Applicants must be a high school junior (11th grade), high school senior (12th grade) or the equivalent for students learning at home. Applicants should be students who are recognized as leaders by their peers, hold leadership positions in the school, active in the community and strive for academic excellence.
