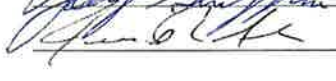

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There came on for consideration at a duly constituted meeting of the Board of Aldermen and Mayor of the City of Long Beach held on the 6th day of August 2026, the following Resolution, which was reduced to writing and presented in advance of the meeting for reading and examination:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH REQUESTING THE ASSISTANCE OF HARRISON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PURSUANT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BY PROVIDING ONE SURPLUS VEHICLE FOR USE IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH.

WHEREAS, the CITY OF LONG BEACH (the CITY) is requesting one (1) surplus vehicle for business use in the City of Long Beach as the city continues to grow and dependable transportation has become increasingly important.

WHEREAS, receiving one surplus vehicle from Harrison County would greatly enhance the City's ability to efficiently respond to transportation of equipment and supplies, and perform daily operations throughout the City of Long Beach.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Long Beach, as follows:

Alderman Frazer made a motion to adopt, seconded by Alderman McCaffrey the adoption of the foregoing Resolution and the question being put to a roll call vote, the result was as follows:

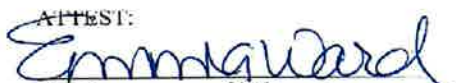
This motion to adopt the Resolution, having received the vote shown above, was therefore declared carried.

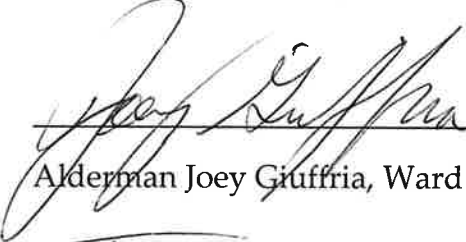

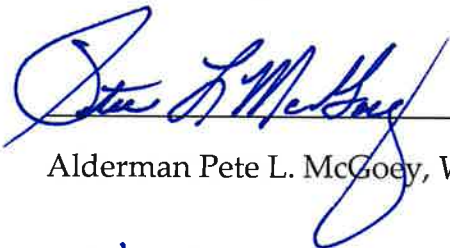

Alderman Patrick Bennett, Ward 1


Alderman Jesse Allen, Ward 2

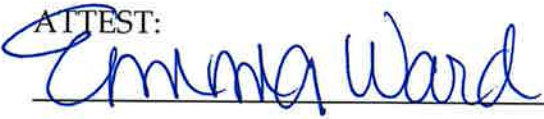
