## CITY OF LONG BEACH ISSUES WARNING REGARDING SCAM ACTIVITY

**Long Beach, MS, April 14, 2026**– The City of Long Beach has recently received multiple calls and emails from residents reporting scam attempts from individuals falsely posing as representatives of the City.

City officials want to remind the public that the City of Long Beach will **never** request payments to be wired or sent digitally. The City does not solicit payments through email, text messages, or any unofficial online methods.

Residents are urged to remain cautious. If you receive any communication claiming to be from the City requesting digital payment, do not respond, do not provide personal or financial information, and do not send money.

Additionally, if you receive any suspicious correspondence by mail that appears to be from the City of Long Beach, please contact City Hall directly or visit in person to verify its legitimacy before making any payments.

The City of Long Beach takes these matters seriously and is committed to protecting its residents from fraudulent activity. Citizens are encouraged to report any suspected scams and to share this information with others in the community.
